This ceiling lamp by Harald Notini was designed in the 1930s and features a mouth-blown glass shade that emits a soft, warm light, creating an inviting atmosphere in any room. The delicate interplay of the cane-wrapped design around the glass adds a refined texture, providing both structural and aesthetic appeal. Suspended by a brass rod, the combination of materials—glass, cane, and brass—offers a timeless, yet distinctively Nordic feel.

Harald Notini, a prolific designer for Böhlmarks, was known for his innovative use of materials and form, making this lamp a perfect representation of Swedish craftsmanship during the era.
