Brass and green lacquered sheet metal. This pair of floor lamps, model 2564, was designed by Josef Frank for the renowned Swedish furniture manufacturer, Svenskt Tenn. The lamps feature a striking combination of materials: sleek brass stems that are complimented by green lacquered sheet metal shades, providing a sophisticated contrast. The sturdy brass base is mounted on small inconspicuous feet, adding subtle elevation to the design. Josef Frank designed the lamps with according to clean lines and classic Nordic design principles. Ideal for both modern and traditional interiors, these lamps offer refined yet understated sources of ambient lighting. The shades
